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## **Program Coordinator CCSN Consultation Services**

### **Primary responsibilities include:**

- Providing consultation to school teams with established special education programs to support learners with complex learning and behavioral needs.
- Completing professional documentation of clinical and consultative activities.
- Supervising a small team of BCBA consultants, providing clinical case review opportunities and feedback.
- Attending consult division meetings and other internal meetings onsite at CCSN's Farmington office.
- Working directly with CCSN's leadership team to support service development and quality assurance initiatives.
- Directing internal division activities such as clinical team meetings, professional development, and supervision of team members.
- Developing and helping coordinate professional development opportunities for certified and non-certified staff in districts.
- Coordinating with CCSN's administrative team as needed.

### **The successful candidate will possess:**

- Be a Licensed Behavior Analyst (LBA) in good standing with the State of Connecticut and either a BCBA or BCBA-D
- Have experience in delivering evidence-based treatment to children with ASD and other learning needs for at least 3 years with at least 1 year of supervisory experience.
- Have experience coordinating professional development and training opportunities for direct care staff.
- Have experience in supervising BCBA's and providing support in clinical case reviews.
- Have strong communication, organization, and collaboration skills.
- Desire to work as part of a large multidisciplinary team of BCBA's, psychologists, occupational therapists, and speech pathologists.

- Weekly participation in clinical teams and CCSN leadership teams.
- Participation in center-based professional development for Type 2 CEs.
- Opportunities for growth and development of clinical skills.
- Collaboration with an interdisciplinary team of clinicians throughout the organization.
