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## **Program Director CCSN BH: Farmington ABA Clinic**

**CCSN Behavioral Health** is excited to announce that we are seeking a **Program Director** and **Licensed Behavior Analyst** to lead our ABA Clinic based in Farmington, CT.

### **Primary responsibilities include:**

- Supervise a large team of behavior analysts and behavior technicians.
- Coordinate administrative and clinical activities for our entire ABA clinic in Farmington, CT.
- Work directly with CCSN's leadership team to support service development and quality assurance initiatives.
- Direct internal division activities such as division meetings, professional development, and supervision of team members.
- Summarize and report on divisional priorities for service quality and delivery.
- The Program Director must also coordinate clinic services with all other clinical teams at CCSN BH.
- Ability to provide direct treatment and supervision of services to children and adolescents with an autism spectrum disorder (ASD) and related neurodevelopmental disorders primarily in a clinic-based setting with opportunities for generalization in homes and community settings.

### **The successful candidate will possess:**

- Be a Licensed Behavior Analyst (LBA) in good standing with the State of Connecticut and either a BCBA or BCBA-D.
- Experience in delivering evidence-based treatment to children with ASD for at least 5 years with at least 2 years of supervisory experience.
- Experience in supporting daily logistics of center-based ABA.
- Experience in supervising BCBAs and coordinating treatment schedules for multiple providers.
- Strong communication, organization, and collaboration skills.
- Desire to work as part of a large multidisciplinary team of BCBAs, psychologists, psychotherapists, occupational therapists, and speech pathologists.

### **This position also includes:**

- Weekly direct team supervision and support.
- Weekly participation in clinical teams and CCSN leadership teams.
- Participation in center-based professional development for Type 2 CEs.
- Opportunities for growth and development of clinical skills.
- Collaboration with an interdisciplinary team of clinicians throughout the organization.

The successful candidate will receive full CCSN benefits which includes the following: competitive salary, medical/dental, paid time off, life insurance, long-term and short-term disability insurance, and retirement contributions. This position is a full-time position (40 hours/week).
